Smart Steps Childcare Payment Assistance

The Smart Steps Childcare Assistance Program is available to income-eligible working parents and parents pursuing post-secondary educational goals that have children ages six weeks to kindergarten. Families that participate in Smart Steps are responsible for a portion of their childcare costs or co-pay based on a sliding income scale.
