

Rosemary Rogers Research Center, Thigpen Library

Purpose

The Rosemary Rogers Research Center is the Library's center for teaching classes and individuals how to research and use library resources.

Priority Usage

1. Classes using library resources under the guidance of a Librarian.
Instructors who sign up for library/research instruction, led by a Librarian, may also request one additional session of research "lab time", during which the class may use the library classroom without library instruction at this priority level.
2. Special sessions or workshops led by a Librarian.
3. Classes, with an instructor present, that are using library resources for research or other class projects.
4. Classes, without instructor present, that are using library resources for research or other class projects.
5. Classes, with an instructor present, needing computer access on a sporadic or limited basis, but are not using library resources.
6. Trevecca University and other universities meeting at Volunteer State.
7. Individual Volunteer State students who need a computer for academic purposes may use these computers, without librarian research assistance, when the library computer lab is full.

Reservations

Reservations for library instruction sessions are granted upon request, when available.

Reservations for classes using library resources without library instruction can be requested at any time, but use of the Center is not granted until one week before the requested date. A request to use the Center for library instruction takes precedence any time prior to the granting of approval.

Reservations for classes not using library resources can be requested at any time but use of the Center is not granted until one week before the requested date. A request to use the Center for library instruction or a class needing to use library resources takes precedence any time prior to the granting of approval.

The room is not reserved for meetings, use by the community, or staff training.
