### ABOUT PRESIDENT'S AMBASSADORS

The President's Ambassador Program is the result of the Office of Admissions' efforts to utilize the best voice of the campus --its students-- in getting the word out about the campus and its resources. Ambassadors will represent the President, the college, the student body, and Vol State individual programs. **This program provides a full scholarship at Vol State for the 2020-2021 Academic Year and includes a \$300 book stipend.**

An Ambassador is a motivated and caring student who has a desire to work with faculty, staff, students, and members of the community. They will assist with campus tours, special events, speaking engagements, phone-a-thons, and community service.

### ABOUT THE APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants must have earned at least 12 credits at Vol State with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 in order to be eligible for consideration. The application packet must be completed and turned in **no later than 4:30pm on Friday, March 6 2020**. Applications may be submitted in person to the Admissions Office, Ramer 120 or by email to [presidentsambassadors@volstate.edu](mailto:presidentsambassadors@volstate.edu). All applicants must schedule an interview time in the Admissions office before the application deadline, either in person or call 615-230-3688. First round interviews will take place **March 16-19<sup>th</sup>**.

## PART IV: DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

### PRESIDENT'S AMBASSADORS

#### *DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES*

#### **Academic Expectations:**

- Maintain enrollment for the 2020-2021 academic year (minimum of 6 hours per semester)
- Maintain a Grade Point Average of no lower than 3.0 cumulative
- Remain in good academic and disciplinary standing with the College

#### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

1. Complete one (1) **mandatory office hour** a week and attend **team meetings** in the Fall & Spring semesters to include:
  - Campus tour (9:30am-10:30am or 2:30-3:30pm - Gallatin Campus)
  - (Note: CHEC and Livingston ambassadors work office hours in place of tours/events.)
  - Completing tasks as assigned by Supervisor
  - Meetings for updates on events and communication information
2. Attend **mandatory** scheduled training dates:
  - May 12th-May 13th, 8:30am - 5:30pm *Training held on the Gallatin Campus*
  - *Check Vol State email daily and respond to emails timely and professionally - year round.*

Mandatory events will also include other events assigned to the Ambassadors throughout the academic year. Events and assignments may involve some weekdays, evenings, and weekends, but will be distributed amongst Ambassadors as evenly as possible and advance notice will be provided.

3. President's Ambassadors must commit to **one year of service**. The one year commitment structure is as follows:

A **minimum** of the following is required by each Ambassador during his or her terms of service:

- 20 hours for Summer 2020 (which includes training hours)
- 40 hours for Fall 2020
- 40 hours for Spring 2021

Note: All ambassadors are expected to display a willingness to help and serve throughout the year - even if the minimum hours have been completed.
