ABOUT PRESIDENT'S AMBASSADORS

The President's Ambassador Program is the result of the Office of Admissions' efforts to utilize the best voice of the campus --its students-- in "getting the word out" about the campus and its resources. Ambassadors will represent the college, the student body, and its individual programs. **This program provides a full scholarship at Vol State for the 2019-2020 Academic Year which includes a \$300 book stipend.**

An Ambassador is a student who has a desire to work with faculty, staff, students, and members of the community. They will assist with campus tours, special events, phone-a-thons, speaking engagements, and community service.

ABOUT THE APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants must have earned at least 12 credits at Vol State with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 in order to be eligible for consideration. The application packet must be completed and turned in **no later than 4:30pm on Tuesday, March 12, 2019**. Applications may be submitted in person to the Admissions Office, Ramer 173 or by email to presidentsambassadors@volstate.edu. All applicants must sign-up for an interview time in the Admissions office before the application deadline. First round interviews will take place **March 11-15th**.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Academic Expectations:

- Maintain enrollment for the 2019-2020 academic year (minimum of 6 hours per semester)
- Maintain a Grade Point Average of no lower than 3.0 cumulative
- Remain in good academic and disciplinary standing with the College

Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Complete one (1) **mandatory office hour** a week and attend a **team meeting** once a month in the Fall & Spring semesters to include:
 - Campus tour (9:30am-10:30am or 2:30-3:30pm)
 - Completing tasks as assigned by Admissions
 - Meeting for updates on events and communication information
2. Attend these **mandatory** scheduled events:
 - May 14-16th *Ambassador Training dates*
 - June 19-20th *Tennessee Board of Regents (TBR) Meeting*

Mandatory events will also include other events assigned to the Ambassadors throughout the academic year. Events and assignments may involve some weekdays, evenings, and weekends, but will be distributed amongst Ambassadors as evenly as possible.

3. President's Ambassadors must commit to **one year of service**. The one year commitment structure is as follows:

A **minimum** of the following is required by each Ambassador during his or her terms of service:

- 20 hours for Summer 2019
- 40 hours for Fall 2019
- 40 hours for Spring 2020

All ambassadors are expected to display a willingness to help and serve throughout the year even if the minimum hours have been completed.

- Check email **daily** and respond to emails timely and professionally
