# **Buy Textbooks**

My Vol State Portal (portal.volstate.edu) > Buy Textbooks

#### Where can you buy your textbooks?

The Vol State Bookstore (either in person or online) is usually the best option. Why?

- The right stuff: The Vol State bookstore is guaranteed to know the correct books and correct editions you need for the specific classes and sections on your schedule. The same book but the wrong edition is still the wrong book!
- Already included in bill: Some books are "IncludED" in your tuition bill, meaning the book charge is on your bill and you just need to access them on eLearn (or, in rare cases, pick up in store. Check email.) Don't pay again at another store!
- Access codes: Some books have one-time-use access codes required in order to access a website to do homework for class.
- Financial Aid: Check your Vol State email regularly.
   Students who have a refund credit will receive an email one week before classes begin with details about when and how they can charge books in the Vol State Bookstore against their refund balance. If Financial Aid creates a refund after the email deadline you will not receive authorization to charge your books.
- **Options:** You can rent textbooks or buy new or used textbooks (options depend on availability).
- The Cashier's Office/Business Office will begin issuing refunds one week after classes begin.

### Why buy your books by the first day of class?

- **Ready to go:** If the professor assigns homework or readings the first day, **you're covered!**
- Sold out: If you wait until after the semester starts to buy your books, the bookstore could be sold out and have to backorder your books which could take a couple of weeks!
   Then you'll be really behind in your classes!
- Save your receipts: If you're unsure if you'll keep the class or if the professor will require the books, postpone using codes or opening shrink wrap so you can return the books by the refund deadline, if needed. Check your receipts for return policies.

# **Get Your Student ID**

# To obtain a Student ID, do the following:

- ☐ Register for classes.
- ☐ Know your Vol State V-number.
- ☐ Provide a valid driver's license, passport, or government-issued ID to confirm your identity.
- ☐ Pick up your student ID:
  - Gallatin students: Ramer Admin Building Front Desk

- Cookeville students: Cookeville Center front desk
- Livingston students: Livingston Center front desk
- **Springfield students:** Springfield Center front desk

If you lose your Student ID, there will be a \$10 charge to reprint a new ID.

# **Get Your Parking Pass**

#### To obtain your parking pass, do the following:
