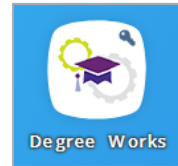


# Degree Works: Your Guided Path to Graduation

Log into your [My Vol State Portal](#)<sup>1</sup> and click on the **Degree Works** icon. (<sup>1</sup><https://launchpad.classlink.com/volstate>)



The **Degree Works: Graduation Audit** worksheet is divided into **block sections**. The blocks and the information within them may differ from student to student, based on the major and other unique elements. The most common blocks are:

- Student Information
- Degree (graduation summary)
- Learning Support Requirements
- Prerequisite Requirements
- Major (credit summary)
- General Education
- Area of Emphasis or Concentration
- Unused Courses & Insufficient Courses (not used towards graduation)

**Student Information.** View your V#, Classification, current Program, assigned Academic Advisor, Graduation Status, Academic Standing, and more. Check your Degree Progress, GPA, or Refresh your audit to see the most up to date information.

**Degree (graduation summary).** View all graduation requirements including block summaries and required exit exam(s), minimum GPA, residency, total credits, and graduation status.

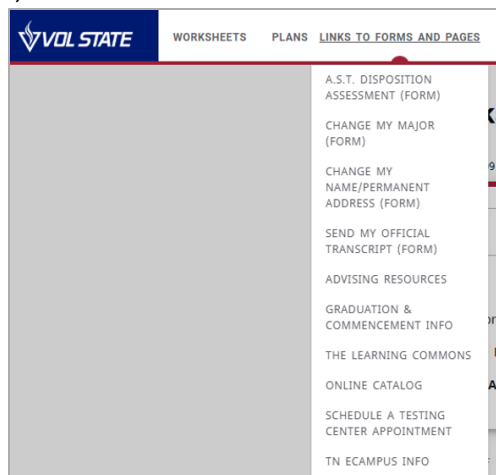

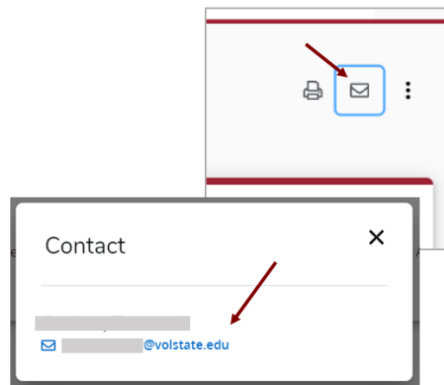
