Education Advising Tips:

A bachelors degree in Education is required to become a licensed classroom teacher in Tennessee.

Teaching, A.S.T. degrees require a 2.75 minimum graduation GPA. A and B grades are important from the beginning. **University Parallel, A.S. - Secondary Education** is a broad starting place for middle/high school education tracks and will require selecting a subject specialty (Math, English, Biology, etc.) and grade range at the bachelors level.

EDU, EDUC, ECED courses require field observation hours in each course. This is observing, **not** "student teaching". These courses can be taken in any order or combination but may have limited semester availability.
