# SSE Areas of Study with Multiple Degree Types

#### Education

- Early Childhood Education Technical Certificate (8 ECED courses no placement scores required)
- Teaching, A.S.T. Early Childhood Education (Pre K-3) (TTP) (Pre K 3<sup>rd</sup> grade teaching license pathway)
- Teaching, A.S.T. Elementary Education (K-5) (TTP) (Kindergarten 5<sup>th</sup> grade teaching license pathway)
- Teaching, A.S.T. Secondary Education (English) (TTP) (Middle or high school teaching license pathway)
- Teaching, A.S.T. Secondary Education (Math) (TTP) (Middle or high school teaching license pathway)
- Teaching, A.S.T. Secondary Education (Social Studies) (TTP) (Middle or high school teaching license pathway)

### **Education Advising Tips:**

A bachelors degree in Education is required to become a licensed classroom teacher in Tennessee.

**Teaching, A.S.T. degrees** require a 2.75 minimum graduation GPA. A and B grades are important from the beginning. **Early Childhood Education and Elementary Education** majors should take MATH 0105/1005 as their first math courses.

**University Parallel, A.S. - Secondary Education** is a broad starting place for middle/high school education tracks and will require selecting a subject specialty (Math, English, Biology, etc.) and grade range at the bachelors level.

**Teaching Degrees** require observation hours. **EDU, EDUC, ECED courses** require 10 hours of field observation hours in each course. This is observing, **not** "student teaching". These courses can be taken in any order or combination but may have limited semester availability.

**Background Checks** are required for all student planning to be licensed for PreK to 12 credentials. If you are unable to pass a background check, please meet with your assigned advisor to discuss other career options.

Praxis / ACT: All degrees in teaching require either an ACT of 21, OR pass all three sections of the Praxis CORE exam. Minimum Praxis CORE scores are Writing=162, Reading=156, Mathematics=150. Schedule an appointment for the exam at http://www.ets.org/praxis using the following test code: Combined test (5752). If retesting is necessary, use the individual test code(s): Reading (5713), Writing (5723), and Mathematics (5733).

#### **Criminal Justice**

- Correctional Officer Technical Certificate (5 CRMJ courses can be embedded in CRMJ AAS with CRMJ 1325 & 1341 as AAS electives)
- Criminal Justice Technical Certificate (5 CRMJ courses embedded in CRMJ AAS)
- Criminal Justice, A.A.S. (Not a transfer pathway requires 1 Gen. Ed. Math or 1 Gen. Ed. Science)
- University Parallel, A.A. Criminal Justice (TTP)

#### Criminal Justice Advising Tips:

CRMJ can be taken in any order or combination.

**Background Checks** are required for all student planning to go into the field of Criminal Justice. If you are unable to pass a background check, please meet with your assigned advisor to discuss other career options.

#### **Exercise Science AS TTP**

**BIOL 2010:** It is required that students have an *ACT composite* of 19 or higher. If the student does not meet the ACT requirement they are required to complete BIOL 1030 or CHEM 1030 prior to taking this course.
