



Placement Worksheet

This worksheet will help determine current placement in English, Reading, and Math and whether the ACCUPLACER placement test or Learning Support courses are recommended. Visit www.volstate.edu/placement for additional information.

College-Level Reading (Select any that apply)

If any of these apply, the Reading placement test is not needed.

- High school GPA of 3.6 or higher, within the past 5 years
 - ACT Reading score of 19 or higher, within the past 5 years
 - SAT Reading and Writing score of 500 or higher, within the past 5 years
 - ACCUPLACER Reading score of 250 or higher, within the past 5 years
 - *Prior college credit for English, Psychology, History, Sociology, etc., with a grade of "D" or higher
 - Prior credit for Learning Support Reading from a TBR institution

- None of the above apply - Take ACCUPLACER Reading test or enroll in Learning Support Reading (READ 0810) plus English Composition I (ENGL 1010) or Introduction to Psychology (PSYC 1030).

College-Level English (Select any that apply)

If any of these apply, the Writing placement test is not needed.

- High school GPA of 3.6 or higher, within the past 5 years
 - ACT English score of 18 or higher, within the past 5 years
 - SAT Reading and Writing score of 490 or higher, within the past 5 years
 - ACCUPLACER Writing score of 250 or higher, within the past 5 years
 - *Prior college credit for English, equivalent to Vol State ENGL 1010, with a grade of "D" or higher
 - Prior credit for Learning Support Writing from a TBR institution

- None of the above apply - Take ACCUPLACER Writing test or enroll in Learning Support Writing (ENGL 0810) plus English Composition I (ENGL 1010).

College-Level Math (Select any that apply)

If any of these apply, the Math (QRAS) placement test is not needed.

- High school GPA of 3.6 or higher, within the past 5 years
 - ACT Math score of 19 or higher, within the past 5 years
 - SAT Math score of 500 or higher, within the past 5 years
 - Completed SAILS Plus math program in high school, within the past 5 years
 - ACCUPLACER Math (QRAS) score of 250 or higher, within the past 5 years
 - *Prior college credit for College Algebra or Pre-Calculus, with a grade of "D" or higher
 - Prior credit for Learning Support Math from a TBR institution

If one of these applies, consult with an advisor for placement information depending on area of study.

- Completed SAILS Math, SAILS Statistics, or SAILS Algebra program in high school, within the past 5 years
 - *Prior college credit for other Math courses (may affect placement depending on area of study)

- None of the above - Take *ACCUPLACER Math (QRAS) test or enroll in **Learning Support Math.
*The name of the ACCUPLACER Math test is Quantitative Reasoning, Algebra, & Statistics (QRAS).
**The Learning Support/College-Level Math combination is determined by your program of study.

*Prior college credit must be from a regionally accredited institution (chea.org/regional-accrediting-organizations).

ACCUPLACER Information
