## **Hostage Situation**

- Anyone taken hostage is encouraged to remain calm, avoid emotional displays, cooperate
  with the hostage taker, do not volunteer information but answer questions. Keep a low
  profile, get rid of personal effects and symbols of authority if possible; never argue, lie,
  confront, or provoke your abductor. Do not try to take negotiations in your own hands and
  follow the instructions of law enforcement officers.
- When a hostage situation is discovered, the person who can safely make the call will notify the Campus Police Department.
  - a. Be patient; time is on your side.
  - b. Follow instructions and be alert.
  - c. Do not speak unless spoken to.
  - d. Be observant.
  - e. Be prepared to answer the police on the phone.
  - f. If medications, first aid or restroom privileges are needed by anyone say so.
- If the hostage taker makes demands, no one should negotiate with him but indicate that someone who can talk to him about those demands is coming.
