Thank you for your interest in the EMS programs at Volunteer State Community College. Our EMS programs are designed to prepare you to enter the work force and provide you with a strong foundation for continuing your Health Sciences career. The EMT Certificate program consists of one semester of full time study and is offered in a variety of locations. The Advanced EMT Certificate program consists of one semester of full time study and is offered in a variety of locations. Seats are limited and the classes usually fill quickly on first come first served basis.

Please note that the application process is your first step and is not registration into the classes. **You must register during one of the official registration periods and attend one of our advising sessions.** You will receive a registration time from the Office of Admissions after your initial application is processed. The chances of getting into the course that you want are greatly enhanced by returning your application as soon as possible. In the event you are not able to get your desired class you may improve your chances for entering the program by completing other core requirements and establishing yourself as a VSCC student. **Before official admission into these programs, students must complete an approved background check.**
