



## INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION

The program fee covers airfare from Nashville to program location, tuition, in-country travel, two meals per day, housing (hostels, hotels, dorm, or homestay), entrance into all museums, historical sites, etc., and basic coverage travel insurance.

Students will be responsible for the cost of additional meals (two per day are provided), passport and VISA if required by country, travel to Nashville airport, overweight luggage, personal incidentals, and personal shopping.

All students will be required to pay all or a portion of the program fee, regardless whether it is a TnCIS program or a VSCC faculty-led Spring Break program.

There are 12 TnCIS.org scholarships available to cover 50% of the program fee. Program fees vary by country. The program fees are located at TnCIS.org.

The program fee for the VSCC faculty-led Spring Break India program is \$3,500. There is a \$1,000 scholarship available for each student who applies and qualifies for the India program.
