Course substitutions: after your official transcripts have been processed you may find courses that were not automatically approved. Please contact your advisor to determine if any substitutions can be allowed. Your transcript should demonstrate that you have successfully completed or be currently enrolled in all of the first-year prerequisite courses (A grade of C or higher is required for transfer of credits into the program (ENGL 1010, PSYC 1030 & Fine Arts). Grades of "D" or "F", or courses with a grade of "incomplete" will not count toward meeting this requirement.

Transfer students should apply to the college and have official transcripts sent to the Admissions Office as soon as possible to ensure that transfer courses are accepted by VSCC. Do not assume your transfer courses will be accepted.

A grade of B or higher is required in the Math and Sciences courses to be considered for an invitation to interview.

Failure to follow these directions and correctly submit all required documentation will result in your application not being considered for the 2020–2021 class.

All documents must be received at the address on the Screening Application by 4:00 p.m. May 1, 2020 or your application will not be considered.
