Exemptions from Job Placement Rates

Some students were exempted from the placement rates in accordance with the standards of the Higher Education Authorization Act due to the following reasons: enrollment in further education, military service, a medical condition that prevents the graduate from working in his/her field of study, family or home responsibilities that prevent the graduate from working in his/her field of study. Exemptions are made in accordance with standards set forth in the Tennessee Quality Assurance model.

Sources of Information, Timeframe, and Methodology

This data is collected using accepted survey methodology. Data collection begins six months after graduation. Graduates surveyed include those who received certificates, AAS, AFA, or AST degrees.
