



## Chapter 31: Veteran Readiness & Employment (VR&E)

### What This Benefit Offers

- **Full Coverage:** Covers 100% of tuition and mandatory fees.
- **Supplies:** Covers books and required supplies through the Vol State bookstore.
- **Subsistence Allowance:** A monthly stipend paid to the Veteran. Please reference the VR&E Website for more information.

### Student Guidelines & Vol State Regulations

- **Authorization:** Your VR&E Counselor must submit an authorization (Tungsten) to the Vol State SCO.
- **Bookstore Vouchers:** Coordinate with the SCO office to ensure your bookstore account is credited for required supplies.
- **Veterans Certification Request Form Requirement:** Even though your counselor authorizes the benefit, you must still submit the Vol State VCRF, so your advisor knows you have registered.
