CSHO General Industry Program Description

Participants in the Certified Safety & Health Official Certificate Program must complete a minimum of thirteen (13) courses, comprised of required and elective courses, to earn the Certified Safety & Health Official General Industry certificate. Only OSHA numbered courses taken at an OSHA Training Institute Education Center will be accepted.

- must complete eight (8) Required Courses from the General Industry list.
- must complete a minimum of five (5) Elective Courses from the industry list.
 - ❖ Short Courses (3 short courses count as 1 elective, maximum short courses allowed is 6)
- A minimum of 9 courses must have been taken with Volunteer State OTIEC – OSHA Training Institute Education Center.
 - ❖ Other required and elective courses may be transferred from any OSHA Training Institute Education Center.
 - ❖ Proof of successful course completion is required.
